

## Police Officer

The Coffeyville Police Department is seeking a qualified individual to fill a vacant Police Officer position. The Coffeyville Police Department is authorized to maintain 28 sworn officers serving approximately 10,000 residents.

### Minimum Requirements

High School Diploma or GED, No felony or domestic violence convictions, good driving record.

Written Test, Physical Agility Test, Oral Interview, Background Investigation, Psychological Test Battery and Medical Examination including Drug Screen.

The successful applicant must successfully complete FTO program and one-year probationary period.

Residency Requirement: Must reside within the USD 445 School District.

Non-certified applicants starting hourly pay: \$14.21/hour

Certified applicants starting hourly pay: \$15.67/hour

Maximum Patrol Officer hourly pay: \$18.24/hour
