

**ORDINANCE NO. G-18-01**

**AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING ELECTRIC RATE SCHEDULE LEP-17 PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 42 (UTILITIES), ARTICLE 1 (IN GENERAL), SECTION 42-6 (RATES INCORPORATED), OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF COFFEYVILLE, KANSAS.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COFFEYVILLE, KANSAS:

Section 1. That the following Rate Schedule LEP-17 is hereby adopted pursuant to Chapter 42 (Utilities), Article 1 (In General), Section 42-6 (Rates Incorporated), of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Coffeyville, Kansas:

**RATE SCHEDULE LEP-17  
LINE EXTENSION POLICY**

**AVAILABILITY:**

- Offered to new or expanding customers for the purpose of connection or upgrading connection to the City of Coffeyville Electric System

**CHARACTER OF SERVICE / APPLICABILITY:**

- All Customer Classes, assigned by appropriate rate code.
- In the event that upgrading, construction, or extension of facilities is required to provide service to an applicant, the City of Coffeyville will furnish the facilities required up to the allowable construction credit established for the corresponding service classification. Any cost in excess of the allowable construction credit shall be the responsibility of the customer.
- The estimated construction investment shall include the costs of materials, equipment, engineering and labor, including administration overheads, fringe benefits, and the cost of service transformers and metering equipment, needed to complete the construction for service to the applicant. The estimated construction investment will include only the non-betterment cost of the construction required to provide service to the applicant. A non-betterment cost excludes the costs of replacement or addition of facilities solely for the benefit and at the election of the City of Coffeyville.
- Where the estimated construction investment exceeds the established allowable construction credit, the City of Coffeyville will charge the applicant or receive from applicant an "In-Aid-To-Construction" contribution. Any In-Aid-to-Construction contribution from applicant must be approved by the City of Coffeyville and determined as the monetary difference of the non-betterment portion of the estimate construction investment less the allowable credit established by this policy.
- The City of Coffeyville will connect facilities up to the metering point of the customer. Costs beyond the metering point are the responsibility of the customer and not subject to contribution from the City of Coffeyville.

**LINE EXTENSION CHARGES:**

Allowable construction credits established by this policy are as follows:

The service furnished to a customer of the City of Coffeyville is subject to the following maximum contributions. Cost in excess of the amounts listed below are subject to an in-aid-to-construction contribution from the applicant.

- Residential Service: \$ 1,127.00 per customer connection
- General Service with Demand: \$ 13,770.00 per customer connection
- Industrial Large Power: \$ 276,014.00 per customer connection
- Residential Developer: \$ 824.00 per customer connection  
(2 or more Units)

Section 2. That all other rate schedules adopted pursuant to Section 42-6 of the Code of Ordinances shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. That any conflicting ordinances, or parts thereof, are hereby repealed.


Section 4. This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication of a summary hereof in the official city newspaper, as provided by law.


