**CFD Responds to Early Morning Structure Fire**

The Coffeyville Fire Department was dispatched a structure fire at 304 East Sixth Street at 4 a.m. Sunday morning. Upon arrival, flames and smoke were visible.

CFD and the Coffeyville Police Department were unaware if occupants were still inside. After a search, it was determined the house was unoccupied and firefighters had the fire under control at 4:24 a.m. There were no injuries reported.

The cause of the fire, which extended into the attic, was determined to be a wood burning stove protruding through the wall. Damage to the structure, listed as owned by William Mayes, and contents was estimated to be \$20,000. In addition to CPD, off duty firefighters, the South Coffeyville Fire Department and CRMC EMS assisted at the scene.
