

RESOLUTION NO. R-11-77

A RESOLUTION PURSUANT TO K.S.A. 12-504, ET. SEQ., AS AMENDED, AND K.S.A. 13-443, AS AMENDED, SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING ON A PETITION TO VACATE A PORTION OF A STREET RIGHT-OF-WAY IN THE CITY OF COFFEYVILLE, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, KANSAS, ALL AS DESCRIBED IN THE BODY OF THIS RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Coffeyville praying for the vacation of a portion of a street right-of-way more particularly described as follows:

Portion of New Street Vacation

Commencing at the Northwest corner of Lot 1, Block 2, North Park Addition to the City of Coffeyville, Montgomery County, Kansas;

Thence S.89°43'35"E. along the North line of said Lot 1, a distance of 25.00 feet to the West Right of Line of New Street, said point being the Point of Beginning;

Thence continuing N.89°43'35"E. along the North Right of Way line of said New Street a distance of 75.00 feet;

Thence S.00°09'34"E. a distance of 45.00 feet to the South Right of Way line of said New Street;

Thence N.89°43'35"W. along said South Right of Way line a distance of 75.00 feet to the West Right of Way line of said New Street;

Thence N.00°09'34"W. along said West Right of Way line a distance of 45.00 feet to the Point of Beginning and containing 3,375 square feet or 0.077 acres.

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 12-504 et seq., authorizes the City of Coffeyville to vacate streets after giving notice by publication at least one time in a newspaper of general circulation of the date of the public hearing on the vacation petition.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of the City of Coffeyville, Kansas:

That a public hearing will be held on Tuesday, September 27 at 6:30 p.m. in the Commission Room, City Hall, Coffeyville, Kansas, on a petition to vacate a portion of a street right-of-way in the City of Coffeyville, Montgomery County, Kansas, as more particularly described above and all persons interested can appear and be heard under the petition.
