

RESOLUTION NO. R-12-74

A RESOLUTION PURSUANT TO K.S.A. 12-504, ET. SEQ., AS AMENDED, AND K.S.A. 13-443, AS AMENDED, SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING ON A PETITION TO VACATE A PORTION OF STREETS IN THE CITY OF COFFEYVILLE, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, KANSAS, ALL AS DESCRIBED IN THE BODY OF THIS RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Coffeyville praying for the vacation of a portion of streets more particularly described as follows:

A portion of said vacation described more particularly as follows:

New Street from the West Right of Way of Sunflower Street to the East Right of Way of Linden Street, Montgomery Addition to the City of Coffeyville, Montgomery County, Kansas.

The above-mentioned property shall be retained as a Utility Easement by the City of Coffeyville, a municipal corporation of the first class; and

A portion of Martin Street between Block 5 and Block 10, Montgomery's Addition to the City of Coffeyville, Montgomery County, Kansas, said vacation described more particularly as follows:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of Lot 5, Block 5, said Montgomery's Addition; thence West along the south Right of Way line of Martin Street to the east Right of Way of the South Kansas & Oklahoma Railroad; thence northeasterly along said East Right of Way to the North Right of Way line of said Martin Street; thence East along said North Right of Way to the Southwest corner of Lot 3, Block 10, said Montgomery's Addition; thence South to the Point of Beginning.


The above-mentioned property shall be retained as a Utility Easement by the City of Coffeyville, a municipal corporation of the first class.

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 12-504 et seq., authorizes the City of Coffeyville to vacate streets after giving notice by publication at least one time in a newspaper of general circulation of the date of the public hearing on the vacation petition.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of the City of Coffeyville, Kansas:
