

**ORDINANCE G-13-08**

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF COFFEYVILLE, KANSAS; AND INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE CERTAIN FEDERAL MOTOR CARRIER SAFETY REGULATIONS.**


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF COFFEYVILLE, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. There is hereby incorporated by reference for the purpose of regulating traffic upon highways and streets of the City of Coffeyville those certain standard safety regulations known as *Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations*, Parts 382, 383, 385, 387 and 390-399, prepared and published in book form by Mangan Communications, Inc., 315 West Fourth Street, Davenport, Iowa, 52801, 2013 edition (hereinafter the "FMCS Regulations"), save and except such articles, sections, parts, or portions as are hereafter omitted, deleted, modified, or changed. No fewer than three (3) copies of the FMCS Regulations shall be marked or stamped "Official Copy as Adopted by Ordinance No. G-13-07", and to which shall be attached a copy of this ordinance, and filed with the city clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable hours. The police department, municipal judge and all administrative departments of the City charged with enforcement of the ordinance shall be supplied, at the cost of the City, such number of official copies of the FMCS Regulations similarly marked, as may be deemed expedient.


SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to violate the provisions of the FMCS Regulations. The judge of the Municipal Court may, in the manner prescribed by K.S.A. 12-4305 or any amendments thereto, establish a schedule of fines for violations of any section of the FMCS Regulations. Any person who violates the provisions of the FMCS Regulations shall, upon conviction, be punished as set forth in the fine schedule. Any person who violates any provision of the FMCS Regulations for which a fine is not scheduled shall, upon conviction, be punished as follows: (a) A fine of not less than \$100.00 nor more than \$2,500.00; (b) imprisonment for not more than one (1) year; or (c) both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication, as provided by law.


