

## **NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR U.S. EPA BROWNFIELDS CLEANUP GRANT**

### **PROPOSED BIKE/WALKING TRAIL COFFEYVILLE, KANSAS**

The Coffeyville Community Enhancement Foundation (CCEF) is applying for a U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Cleanup Grant for funding proposed remediation activities for the proposed biking/walking trail. The proposed trail runs along the former Missouri Pacific Railroad from west of the intersection of 4<sup>th</sup> Street and Poplar Place north to an area north of the intersection of 1<sup>st</sup> Street and Poplar Place. The proposed remediation will likely include limited excavation of lead impacted soil and construction of a concrete cap.

Draft copies of the grant application and the Draft Analysis of Brownfield Cleanup Alternatives (ABCA) document will be available for public review and comment beginning January 8, 2014 at the Coffeyville Public Library located at 311 W. 10<sup>th</sup> Street in Coffeyville, Kansas. A public meeting is scheduled to coincide with the City Commission meeting held at 6:30pm on January 14, 2014. The meeting is held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor Commission Room, 102 W.
