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Walter Johnson R.V. Parks Rules & Regulations

Violation of these rules may subject violator/camping unit to removal from the Park

Effective July 1, 2021

1. Site Fees are payable in advance (No exceptions).
2. All campers and camping units are limited to a stay of not more than fourteen (14) consecutive days although an extension may be obtained with written permission from the Director of Public Service (620.252.6152) or his/her designee if the party requesting such extension has verifiable, temporary employment in the surrounding area, as a contractor or sub-contractor, an extended stay may be granted, but only at the full service Rivercrest Campground area, and subject to availability. A fourteen (14) day absence is required before returning to the park to camp again. Any property left unused or unoccupied for 48 hours shall be considered abandoned, and is subject to removal by the City, without notice.
3. All R.V.'s and vehicles, etc. must be contained within your designated site.
4. Tents are allowed in the R.V. parks if the site has been paid for in full in advance. There is a 48 hour camping limit for all tents. (No Exceptions) A fourteen (14) day absence is required before returning to the park to camp again. Any property left unused or unoccupied for 48 hours shall be considered abandoned, and is subject to removal by the City, without notice.
5. Your site must be kept neat, clean and free of boxes, litter or trash. No appliances, storage bins, weight sets, etc. are allowed. No junked, unusable or unsightly vehicles will be allowed in the Park. Contact the Director of Public Service (620.252.6152) for questionable items.
6. Businesses are not allowed to be ran from the campgrounds.
7. **DUMPING OF GREY OR BLACK WATER IS PROHIBITED.** Grey & Black water must be disposed of at the dump station unless you are utilizing a full service site at the Rivercrest campground.
8. Shelter houses are for public use and are not dedicated for any campsites. Any unaccompanied items left in a shelter house is subject to removal.
9. Pets are welcome in the Walter Johnson RV Campground. There is a leash law in Coffeyville which prohibits dogs running at large. Please clean up after your pet. There are doggy bags and receptacles conveniently located within the park to dispose of pet waste.
10. Charcoal grills & wood smokers may be used at the campgrounds, unless the County is under a burn ban. Propane and pellet grills are the only grills allowed when under a burn ban.
11. No major vehicle repairs shall be made on these premises. Service work including changing oil and lubing is prohibited.
12. Any cutting of trees or plants is prohibited.
13. Restrooms and showers are accessible 24 hours a day; please help keep them neat and clean. Report any problems immediately.
14. Loud parties, excessive drinking, offensive language, or other unacceptable behavior by guests is not permitted.
15. Quiet hours are from 10:00 PM to 8:00 AM. Generators or any other loud equipment are not to be used during quiet hours.
16. Any unlawful behavior will not be tolerated on city property. If authorities have to be contacted for any unlawful activity perpetrated by you or anyone staying at or visiting your site, you may be required to leave.
17. Clotheslines are not permitted.
18. Dispose of your trash in the poly-carts provided. Do not leave trash outside your unit overnight. All garbage must be placed in plastic bags and tied. Boxes must be flattened.
